Wine Park is an importer of fine wines since 2007 with a curated selection of more than 150 wines from some of the world's finest estates. Wine Park selection showcases all the major grape varieties across red, white, rose and sparkling wines. Our portfolio features a hand-picked selection of wineries with passionate and innovative winemakers crafting wines of great quality and which truly express the region's essence. The wines are exclusively imported from over 53 family owned producers, 12 countries, and over 30 wine regions. Wine Park's journey began when Vishal Kadakia discovered wines and his passion for them as a student in Boston in 1997. He knew that wines would certainly be part of his life.



The name Wine Park is in fact inspired by New York's Central Park where Vishal went on a lot of runs, thinking mostly about wine. Vishal returned to India to find a burgeoning wine scene with room for a more creative approach. Along with his wife, Ashu, he explored the idea importing boutique wines of the type which Indians had never before tasted. Wine Park wanted Indians to discover new and interesting wines – wines with fascinating flavours, compelling stories produced by family owned wineries. The company also wanted to introduce Indian wine drinkers to new wines and new regions. The overarching philosophy was that the best way to sell a bottle of wine was to open it and get more people to taste it. Today, our collection features a range of international wines, catering to a variety of tastes and price points.

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Matias Riccitelli

Mendoza, Argentina



Matias Riccitelli is a young and thrillingly bold winemaker who is reinventing Argentina’s Malbec style and impressing the world with a refreshing approach to winemaking itself. Born to famed Argentine winemaker Jorge Riccitelli, Matias opted to arm himself with valuable international experience working in vineyards across the world and eventually returned home to make his own wines.

Matias chose Mendoza’s Luja de Cuyo region where he owns 20 hectares of ungrafted old vineyards in three distinct microclimates at the foothills of the Andes mountains. Matias Riccitelli wines reflect the young winemaker’s love for the vast Mendoza region and winemaking ethos that marries tradition and modern creativity.

Malbec is the Argentinian flagship variety and the Matias Riccitelli Wines Hey Malbec is a truly sublime interpretation. Juicy black fruits combine with violets and black pepper, with soft and ripe tannins leading a soft and opulent finish. Lovely on its own or with juicy red meat.

MadFish

Margaret River, Australia



Madfish is a cult family estate based in Western Australia’s famous region of Margaret River founded in 1992 by Jeff Burch, an avid surfer and lover of wine with a deep understanding of the region’s unique terroir. The winery draws its name from Madfish Bay an elegant, easy drinking expression from the fruit it’s team harvests from select parcels rooted in Margaret River soils blessed with Mediterranean climate, cool ocean breeze and clay and gravel soil similar to Bordeaux. Madfish also harvests vineyards in the Great Southern wine region that sits between mountain and ocean. Madfish’s wines are refreshing and meant to drink now with vibrant fruit and good acidity, also making them quite food friendly.

Tasting Notes

Savoury notes of cedar spice, mint, dusty cocoa, mocha, and dried sage rise from the vibrant, red fruited core of this wine. The wine unfurls across the palate revealing flavours of ripe raspberry and red liquorice with undercurrents of chocolate and baking spices. Balanced acidity and subtle, powdery tannin play a supporting role to the earthy tones and generous red fruit at the centre of this wine. Deliciously easy to drink with a tantalising depth of flavour.

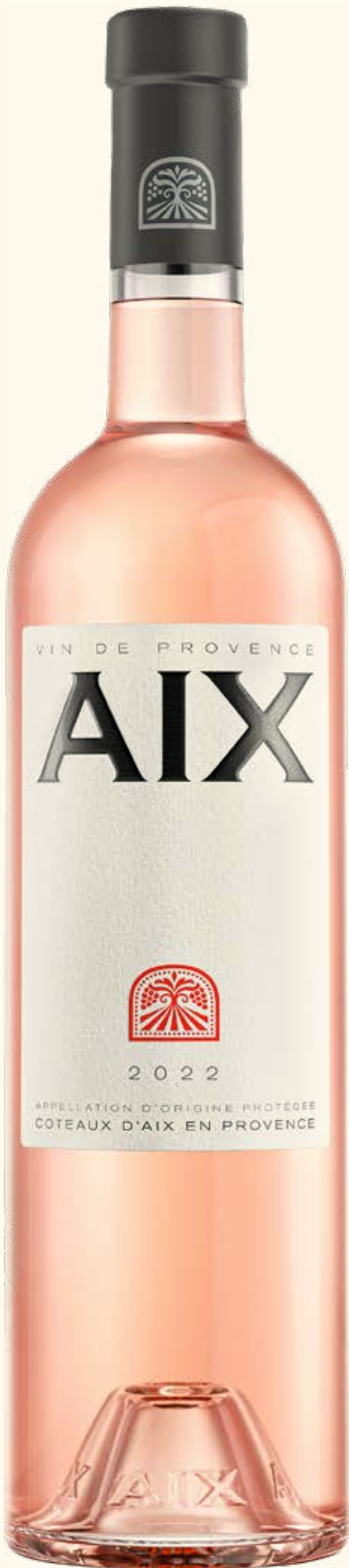

Provence, France



Maison Saint Aix makes its ferment in Southern France’s prestigious AOP Coteaux d’Aix-en-Provence, regarded as perhaps the world’s finest appellation for rose wines. Located close to Aix-en-Provence, Maison Saint Aix has a rich history of over 135 years and puts most of its efforts into producing the single wine, Aix Provence Rose.

With over 75 hectares under vines planted with Grenache, Syrah and Cinsault, the estate is one of the region’s largest. Ideal terroir results in a delightfully ripe rose expression that is delightfully fragrant, abounding with floral aromas and flavours of strawberry and watermelon, enhanced by refreshing acidity.

AIX is a well- balanced premium rose' with a typical hypnotising salmon pink colour. The nose is fresh and fragrant, delicate yet youthful with sophisticated notes of fresh red fruits, peach and subtle flower hints.

Thunevin

Bordeaux/Saint Emilion, France



Jean-Luc Thunevin was never one for following the rules on anything so when he bought his first parcel of Bordeaux vines in St Emilion over 31 years ago, he began reinventing them. What gave was his first vintage of Château Valandraud, one of the world’s first “garage wines”. Working with an innovative approach, Thunevin won over Bordeaux’s foremost critics Robert Parker with 95 points soon after.

Thunevin then emerged as Bordeaux’s quintessential Bad Boy and leading garage vintner. He believes that harvesting and destemming by hand, cropping low yields and using new French oak has translated into the estate’s many sublime vintages. His vineyards are planted in soils of clay and limestone with the region’s top varietals and his wines are intense yet elegant.

This wine shows aromas of black plum, blueberry, clay pot, chocolate, spice and cedar. Blended mainly from Merlot and a jot of Cabernet Sauvignon, the 2016 vintage delivers a full body, polished tannins and balanced acidity. The finish show beautiful fruit notes of tart red currant, tart cherry, anise, leather, incense, chocolate and cedar. Enjoy!

St. Urbans-Hof

Mosel, Germany



Based in the Mosel Valley where Germany’s finest Rieslings are produced, St. Urbans-Hof is a family run winery with impeccable reputation which founder Nicolaus Weis’s grandson Nik has done splendidly to uphold. St. Urbans-Hof vineyards in the Mosel and Saar Valley are gifted with the natural convergence of a cool continental climate and sharply sloped hills rich in slate, yielding fruit of stellar quality.

Nik Weis is a strong believer in deploying centuries old traditional viticulture, some of which date back to the Roman era. Unsurprisingly, St. Urbans-Hof is rated as one of Germany’s finest family run estates.

The nose is rather fruity and floral, while the elegant mouthfeel is dominated by fresh and fine flavours of ripe stone fruits such as peaches and yellow plums. The minerality of the slate soils delivers a salty and spicy character that goes perfectly along with the lively acidity and delicate medium sweetness.

Brancaia

Tuscany, Italy



Brancaia is steeped in family tradition and also the veritable face of modern Tuscan wine. The Widmers' daughter Barbara has been Brancaia's winemaker since 1998, supported by consulting wine maker, the brilliant Dr. Carlo Ferrini, producing complex and elegant wines that best reflect the Tuscan identity. Barbara has been at the forefront of blending Tuscany's flagship grape Sangiovese with international varieties.

Brancaia's three Tuscan vineyards — Castellina and Poppi in Chianti, and Brancaia in Maremma produce wines that frequently win international awards and populate the shelves of wine collectors connoisseurs the world over.

A medium bodied and thoroughly expressive super Tuscan, Brancaia Tre is the harmonious coming together of two noble French grapes, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot with local Italian hero fruit Sangiovese. This elegant red expresses notes with blackberry, cherry and coffee.

Tenuta Sant Antonio

Veneto, Italy



Tenuta Sant’Antonio is a reputed Veneto estate envisioned and run by four brothers who have elevated the style of the Valpolicella and Soave wines. Tenuta Sant’Antonio crushes fruit from its two vineyards located in Val d’Illasi, and Monti Garbi.

It’s the Monti Garbi vineyard where the brothers laid the foundation for producing contemporary wines of high quality under the label Scaia. The Scaia wines receive dimensions of concentration thanks to Monti Garbi’s alluvial soil and the constant stirring of the lees during vinification. The decision to only use steel tanks and not barrels to ferment the wines has turned out wines of freshness and complex fruit expression.

They began their vinous journey in 1994 and along the way, Saint Clair Family Estate won Winestate NZ Winery of the year thrice. This is hardly surprising given the Saint Clair Family Estate’s rigorous focus on producing sublime wine. The winery prides itself on being 100% Family Owned, 100% New Zealand and 100% Sustainable!

Pale straw in color with aromas of tropical notes of passionfruit, grapefruit and blackcurrant combine with herbaceous characters and a subtle salty note. The palate is rich and weighty and full of flavours of grapefruit and blackcurrant along with green notes of nettle and capsicum. A subtle sea salt character leads to a long lingering mineral finish.

With over 250 years of wine making history, Boekenhoutskloof combines traditional wine making craft with contemporary style to create wines that appeal to the modern palate.

Lead by Marc Kent, regarded as a pioneering South African wine maker, whose 1997 Syrah vintage put South Africa in the world's spotlight, the estate consistently produces wines that enthrall its followers and impress the critics. The Boekenhoutskloof portfolio includes a range of single-varietal wines named for the estate as well as The Chocolate Block. MAN Family Wines is a dynamic winery producing several ranges of good-value modern-styled varietal wines in the South African region of Paarl. MAN Family Wines is the brainchild of Jose? Conde of Stark-Conde? and brothers Tyrrel and Philip Myburgh of Joostenberg Wines. Established in 2001, today MAN Family Wines produces over 300 000 cases and exports to more than 45 countries.

The vineyards where the estate sources its fruit from is rich in Malmesbury shale soils that have excellent water-retention ability, yielding fruit that makes wines produce wines that are concentrated and flavourful, with a spicy, mineral character that is typical of the area. MAN Family Wines believes in taking an environmentally sustainable and socially responsible approach to winemaking.

Robertson, South Africa



Robertson Winery is a producer of fine traditional and modern wines, based in South Africa's Robertson Valley in the Western Cape. Robertson Winery was established in 1941 in the town of Robertson, close to Cape Town. The region's first cooperative winery, Robertson Winery is also one of South Africa's biggest, receiving grapes from more than 36 families harvesting 2400 hectares of vineyard.

Cellar master Bowen Botha ensures minimal mechanical influence on the fruit before vinification to retain a natural character. Robertson Winery boasts a range of labels, prominent among them is the natural sweet wine – a style made popular by South Africa which has long had a history of making sweet and fortified wines.
